Dear Sirs;

We have been making custom acrylic bins and fixtures for the retail Bulk Food sector since 1983. We we have grown to over 30 employees and occupy over 19,000 square feet of factory. We are regarded as "leading edge" manufacturers; and own patents, and custom dies on several parts used in the construction of the acrylic containers. We have been asked by several clients to recommend a suitable cleaner for cleaning and sanitizing these containers.

One of the problems with cleaning acrylic products, are that some chemicals (especially those containing alcoholds) will craze or discolour the material. Most containers for the bulk food business are made from sheet material that is manufactured by an "extruded" process. This material is more susceptible to attack by chemicals than "cell cast" material. Because of high competitive pressures for lower prices of these containers, many more are made from acrylic sheet from mills, whose quality is inferior, even though the new product "looks" identical. We only use material from top, reputable producers, of acrylic sheet.

We have test cleaned our materials using your product, Virox broad spectrum cleaner, containing 7% hydrogen peroxide. We soaked them twice per day over a 30 day period, and allowed them to air dry. After this time we did not experience any crazing or discolouring of our sheet acrylic. We have let the subject sheets sit in racks for the past 60 days waiting to observe any long term effects. To date the material has shown none.

We do not express any opinion as to its ability to sanitize, sterilize, purify, or its' effectiveness in its ability to clean grease or other film.
